Student Achievement: College and Career Ready...The Carroll County Way

CCR Numbers: We celebrate that we have a score of 58% on our College and Career Readiness for the class of 2012. 58 out of 106 graduating seniors are CCR and 5 have both college and career readiness.

EOC Numbers: Our early reports show positive results on the Kentucky End of Course Assessments in English 10, Algebra 2, Biology, and US History.
