The Alternative Learning Center (ALC) is a facility that provides new opportunities for students who require alternative placement.

The center serves students in grades 6–12. The curriculum is provided primarily by an online program called Edgenuity, which offers over 100 different courses that are aligned with Kentucky's academic standards.

All students are also offered electives, including reading, arts and humanities and life skills classes. This alternative program allows students to work at their own pace and offers social skills training as well, with a heavy emphasis on preparing students for higher education and employment.

The ALC program is committed to reaching the following goal: all students will be college-, career- and citizenship-ready when they graduate.
